# Who is your Volunteer?

- Are they a retiree wanting to fill some time?
- Are they an accountant willing to share their skills to better the health of the community?
- A College student looking for experience?

What is the Volunteers Goal, and how can we help them achieve this goal

- Take this time to also express expectations for client confidentiality and training

# Clearly explain your VITA program (Getting rid of Intimidation)

1. What is the time Commitment?

During Volunteer orientation ask open ended questions.

2. How do we stay in contact during the tax season?

Ex. What are you the most excited for during your time as a VITA Volunteer? Why?

3. How involved are you as a coordinator during tax time?

- Stay calm
- Actively listen
- Pause and reflect
- Maintain eye contact

4. What Site model are you using? (explain it)

A Volunteer is more likely to return if they feel listened to and understood.
